Health Education Campus - Samson Pavilion Building Use Standards

Purpose:

The Health Education Campus (HEC), and specifically Samson Pavilion, was built to support the educational mission of the health profession programs at Case Western Reserve University and Cleveland Clinic Lerner College of Medicine. To ensure equitable access and a supportive learning environment for all campus users, these Building Use Standards are promulgated.

Scope:

These Building Use Standards apply to anyone seeking to utilize space within the Samson Pavilion. Samson Pavilion is only for the use of CWRU and Cleveland Clinic campus community members, and their guests.

Building Use Standards:

1. Personal Conduct:

All users are expected to be courteous, respectful, and professional while in Samson Pavilion. Disruptive behavior may result in removal from the building and referral to the appropriate CWRU or Cleveland Clinic authority.

2. Priority Use for Health Profession Students:

The primary purpose of Samson Pavilion is to support students enrolled in health profession programs. These include:

- Frances Payne Bolton School of Nursing
- School of Dental Medicine
- School of Medicine, including:
 - MD University Track
 - MD Cleveland Clinic Lerner College of Medicine
 - Physician Assistant Program
 - Master of Science in Anesthesia Program

Students in these programs have equal priority access to all study, collaboration, and lounge spaces throughout the building.

3. Access for Non-Health Profession CWRU and Cleveland Clinic Campus Community Members:

CWRU and Cleveland clinic campus community members who are not enrolled in one of the health profession programs listed above may use **the first-floor atrium area only**. These spaces are available on a first-come, first-served basis, provided there is no conflict with the building's primary academic mission or the needs of the health profession students.

4. Restricted Access to Upper Floors:

The **second floor and above** are designated for the <u>exclusive use</u> of health profession students and building tenants. CWRU and Cleveland Clinic campus community members who are not students/faculty/staff within Samson Pavilion (including all non-health profession students) are restricted from using space on the upper floors. Non-compliance may result in removal from the space and referral to the appropriate CWRU or Cleveland Clinic authority.

5. Exceptions:

Exceptions to these standards must be requested in writing and approved by the Director of HEC Operations.
